

Terms and Conditions for RSASA/SALA Portrait Prize Exhibition



ELIGIBILITY

The RSASA/SALA exhibition is open to all artists and photographers in all mediums.

- > Up to 3 artworks can be submitted by any artist.
- > The works must be the original work of the exhibitor.
- > The work must be the work that was submitted on the entry.
- > The artwork must have been completed after 26/7/2015. (closing date of the last RSASA Portrait Exhibition)

SIZE AND RESTRICTIONS

- > Size is restricted to 100cms in width (framed)
- > One large entry is permitted maximum 200cms in all directions (framed) at an additional fee.
- > The artworks must be suitable to hang with suitable "D" rings and wire.
- > No works will be accepted if the paint is wet.

FINANCIALS

- > Entry fee \$30.00 per artwork non-members.
- > \$15 surcharge for a large artwork over 2 metres.
- > \$5 discount for RSASA Members eg (\$25 per entry for members).
- > All artworks are to be for sale with a 30% commission going to the RSASA.
- > Works not collected by the 31st August will incur a storage fee of \$5 a day.

SUBMISSION OF ENTRY

- > All works will be judged initially from the digital image(digital images are preferred -CD or USB) Please note-image file is to be labeled -family name, given name, name of art work, medium, year of production, height and width of work.
- > Hard copies of images must be A4 in size up to 300DPI (no less than 1MB and have the same written information as above on the back of each page of entry submitted).

JUDGING PRIZES

- > Professional judges using digital images will do the initial judging and their decision will be final.
- > No art work will be eligible for more than one prize.

LEGALS

- > The RSASA reserves the right after consultation with the judges to reject any entry including exhibits unsuitable in presentation or non-compliant.
- > The RSASA will exercise all reasonable care in handling and storing the submitted art works but will not be responsible for the loss of, or damage to, any works while in its custody.
- > Artists are responsible for insuring their own works.
- > The RSASA can photograph the works to use for publicity purposes.
